PARKING AT KINO SPORTS COMPLEX

- Free
- Covered parking available on first come first serve basis
- Handicap parking spaces available
- Security: Parking lot is patrolled by the staff of the Kino Baseball League
- Personal items: Vehicle owners are responsible for securing their vehicle. Do not leave any valuables visible in the vehicle (purses, wallets, money, credit cards, computers, etc.)
- Damage to vehicle: The Pima County Stadium District and Kino Baseball League are not responsible for any damage incurred by a personal vehicle while.

GUEST NEEDED TRANSPORTATION TO FIELDS:

- Kino Baseball League provides transportation for individuals that require assistance to the Main Fields and are available to return back to the main gate at the end of the game. This service is free.
- Individuals sitting on the lap of another person is prohibited.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

- Guests are responsible for their own personal property.
- If property is left behind the staff of the Kino Sports Complex will collect in and store it at the facility.
- Contact Kino Baseball League (730-2506) if personal property is left behind.

BATTED/THROWN BASEBALLS + BATS

- At the Main Fields there are multiple fields. Batted balls from these fields will occur and it is important that our guests are alert for balls off the field of play.
- Guests assume all risks for any batted, thrown ball or bat that leaves the field of play.
- Balls that are batted or thrown from the field of play are to be returned to the field.

CONCESSIONS:

- Full Menu concessions is available.
- Ice is available if required for injury only to a player, coach or guest.
- Payment for concessions by cash, debit or credit card is accepted.

MEDICAL ATTENTION:

- Kino Baseball League provides one (1) athletic trainer that is stationed at the Main Fields
- If medical attention is required at Kino Stadium, the trainer will be transported to the stadium.
- 9-1-1 is called for injuries that require additional medical attention and treatment.

ALCOHOL SERVICE POLICY (MAIN FIELDS + STADIUM (Weekends only))

- Valid I.D. is required for purchase. 100% ID check all ages. Arizona law requires that individuals be able to produce a valid I.D. when requested in order to be served.
- Acceptable forms of valid United States identification for alcoholic beverage purchases are: U.S. Driver's License, Passport, State Issued I.D. Card w/ Photo, Military I.D. w/ Photo.
- International Driver's Licenses are not accepted. Passports are required in those instances.
- Alcohol service is limited to no more than two drinks per person, per identification.
- All alcoholic beverage sales will be discontinued at 9:00 PM, or at the discretion of management.
- All guests must be 21 years of age to purchase an alcoholic beverage.
- Taking any purchased alcohol out of Kino Sports Complex main fields or Kino stadium is prohibited.
- Government Warning: According to the Surgeon General, women should not drink alcoholic beverages during pregnancy because of the risk of birth defects.

RESTROOMS

- Men's and Ladies restrooms are available that does include baby changing tables.

LOST AND FOUND

- During the game lost and found/claimed items can be claimed at the Concession stand.

FAN GROUND RULES

The Pima County Stadium District and the Kino Baseball League staff are committed to providing a safe, comfortable, and friendly atmosphere for all of our guests. The following guidelines have been established regarding guest conduct:

- Guests interfering with the progress of the game or going onto the field will be ejected and subject to arrest.
- Guests wearing obscene or indecent clothing and or body art will not be allowed entry into the ballpark.
- Guests using foul or abusive language or gestures will be ejected from the ballpark.
- Guests appearing intoxicated will be denied entry or ejected from the ballpark.

DAY PASS ADMISSION RATES

- ADULTS \$ 7.00 per person/per day
- Seniors (62 +) \$ 5.00 per person/per day
- Students \$ 1.00 per student/per day
- Military ID + 1 Guest FREE
- 5 and UNDER FREE
- PLAYERS AND COACHES FREE

Re-entry is permitted to the Main Fields by showing the gate attendant the purchased ticket

Day pass purchased at Main Field can be used for access Stadium by showing the gate attendant the purchased ticket

Day pass purchased at the Stadium can be used for access to the Main Fields by showing the gate attendant the purchased ticket.
